The LVGO is a forward thinking, energetic and vibrant orchestra that exclusively performs arrangements of popular video game music. A part of my job is to arrange music alongside a team of arrangers, ensure that we adhere to copyright and licensing laws, whilst also developing relationships and collaborations with other musical organisations such as choirs.

THAME CONCERT BAND (CURRENT)

I'm currently the musical director of the Thame Concert Band and have been leading it since mid 2015 (with one year out due to military training).

When I first arrived the band had eleven regular members, an audience base of eight, and dwindling finances. With my guidance the band has now become attractive to potential new players, and has built an audience base to a level where they always have sellout concerts. They regularly perform a 'Last Night of The Proms' themed concert, and the band has grown to a membership of 42 regulars. They've become a much-loved part of the community, and flourish further each year. We're currently in the process of nurturing relations with various musical organisations in the twinned town of Sinaia, Romania.

During the Pandemic I set the band video projects, arranged music for members to perform, and helped organise COVID secure rehearsals when legally possible; I facilitated a weekly quiz, and gave online talks.

I have also arranged music for them to record their individual parts, and collated them into one video for a 'virtual' performance.

ACB are one of the premier wind bands in the south of the UK and perform regularly to sell out audiences, for instance they regularly perform to 5000 people at their annual 'Proms in the Park' concert.
